Pastors Message

Lions, and Tigers, and Troll Farms-Oh My!

"And he called them to him and said to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? "If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand." And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand." -Mark 3.23-25

The truth of what our Lord declares as recorded by St. Mark runs deeper than its immediate context in the Gospel. Our Lord is specifically addressing the matter of Satan and his conspiring fallen angels. However, this principle applies more broadly to the nations of the world and certainly very poignantly to the United States of America.

I have lived forty years and some months on this earth. Never have I encountered the level of division in which we are now living in this country. We are divided over everything. It could accurately be said that "division" is now our *climate, atmosphere,* and the *air we breathe.* My mere forty years did not allow me to live through the Vietnam War period, however, from all the evidence I can gather, we have clearly surpassed that level of division in our modern-day disunion.

Furthermore, the division today seems to be deeper and more fundamental than that of previous periods. For example, we can't even agree on what biological male and female are anymore. What we *can* agree on however, is that historical record indicates that gender dysphoria presents in the late stages of a civilization as a culture is starting to unravel and decline. The Hellenistic and Roman cultures are certainly prescient examples of this, however a more modern one is that of the post-WW1, Weimar Republic.

All evidence certainly seems to point to the decline of our civilization. Not just in the sense mentioned above, but on a much broader scale. "Science" is the new religion. Freedom of speech is being challenged everywhere in our cancel-culture. True journalism is an artifact of the past. In its place are news conglomerates aligned with one political party or another—usually leaning rather heavily to one side, the result being that the citizenship is exposed only to what this one-sided media wants you to be exposed to. For example, it was just recently revealed that all of the charges of "Russian collusion" regarding the former President of the Untied States were completely fabricated by the opposing political party. This was all over the news. This was all over every social media platform. The problem is, as it turns out, there was zero truth to it. Zero. However, conversely, when there was (and still are) some very concerning issues of national security with one of our current President's sons, the story was silenced by the same media. As you know, I do not care much for the

politics of the "left-hand city of God" however, it's startling that there has been absolutely no repercussions or reprimand for any of this. Truly, a kingdom divided against itself will not stand.

Now, I bring up all of this to point out a potentially more immediate danger that some of us might be the victim of – troll farms. So what is a troll farm? A troll farm is an organization whose goal it is to post online (usually to Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram) intentionally provocative, offensive, or click-bait things for the sole purpose of causing division. People always tend to be a good bit meaner when having a conversation with another person over the internet—I don't think there's anything to do to solve this problem other than not participating in one. However, it is exceptionally concerning that the majority of these troll farms are state-run. It has long been China's strategy (going back to Sun Tzu) that before they attack their enemy, they first weaken them by causing internal strife and division.

In October of 2019 a former Facebook employee gave to the MIT Technological Review a report which revealed that, among other things, 19 of the top 20 Christian pages on Facebook were run by Eastern European troll farms. Yes, 19 out of the top 20! The propaganda of these troll farms has and continues to reach 140 million United States Facebook users per month. Yes, 140,000,000 per month! That is staggering. This propaganda usually comes in the form of unsolicited memes based on things that we've "liked" or commented on in the past. A Facebook user doesn't even need to belong to the particular group in order to receive propaganda in their news feed from it. Truly, we live in a new and terrifying era where our enemies have unbridled and direct access to our nation's citizenship and are so effectively tearing it apart slowly from the inside by turning them against one another.

And so the words of our Lord enter into our

hearts and minds with all of their cautionary force in Mark 13: See that no one leads you astray, many will come in my name saying, 'I am he' and they will lead many astray... nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom... But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. ³⁸ Be on guard, keep awake.
